

## Jan Černý, in Poland to compete in his fourth round in the World Rally Championship 2024

**Repeating on the right with Ondřej Krajča, the Tenerife-based driver arrives at this event in third position in WRC3, 13 points off the lead. This Sunday he will compete in the Rally Warmiński in Poland in preparation for the World Championship event, while on Monday he will reinforce this aspect with a test.**

Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča travel to Poland to compete next week in their fourth round in the 2024 World Rally Championship. Those from Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport face the 80th edition of the Polish rally, a gravel race that will take place characterized by its fast special stages.

The Tenerife-based driver already competed in this rally in 2012 when it was part of the FIA European Rally Championship calendar, although the route from then bears little resemblance to this edition.

The Černý-Krajča couple will land in third position in the WRC3 World Championship, just 13 points behind the lead thanks to the points earned in 'Monte-Carlo', where they won, and in 'Portugal', where they finished on the verge of the podium. Without a doubt, Poland can be the perfect place to close the gap with respect to the first two places.

“We are ready for Rally Poland”, says the Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport driver. In relation to Sunday's rally and Monday's test, Jan Černý assures that he wants to “prepare this race very well, it is very important for us. I want to go fast, we need a good result”. In his opinion, “it is going to be a rally with very high speeds in which we will need good notes and a good pace”.

The 80th Rally Poland will begin on Thursday, June 27, with the shakedown (Lubiewo, 5.1 km) and the first special stage, 'Mikolajki Arena' (2,5 at 7:05 p.m.). On Friday 28, the first leg will be completed with the stages of 'Stanczyk' (29,4 km at 8:45 a.m. and 2:05 p.m.), 'Wieliczki' (12,9 km at 10:20 a.m. and 3:40 p.m.), 'Olecko' (13,2 km at 11:10 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.) and 'Mikolajki Arena' (2,5 at 7:00 p.m.). On Saturday it will be the turn of 'Swietajno' (18,5 km at 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.), 'Goldap' (19,9 km at 9:45 a.m. and 5:15 p.m.), 'Czarne' (22,4 km at 10:35 a.m. and 6:05 p.m.) and a new passage through 'Mikolajki Arena' (2,5 at 1:25 p.m.). The Polish event will end on Sunday, June 30, with the stages of 'Gmina Mragowo' (20,8 km at 9:00 a.m. and 12:20 p.m.) and 'Mikolajki' (11,2 at 10:05 a.m. and 2:15 p.m.).

Before, this Sunday, Jan Černý will compete with the Ford Rally3 and also in Poland, the Rally Warmiński. He will do it with Petr Jindra on the right in order to prepare for the World Rally Championship event. There it will cover, on three times, the stages of 'Łomy' (6.2 km), 'Różyńka' (3.7 km) and 'Barkweda' (9.6 km), for a total of 58.5 km.

To reinforce this fourth round in the World Championship, Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča will hold a test day the following day, Monday 24, where they will finish making the final adjustments to their Ford Rally3.
